Background

Unremitting rains in Karnataka and Maharashtra from the first week of August 2019 glutted the reservoirs, severely affecting the villages in the catchment area of the rivers - Krishna, Malaprabha, Ghataprabha, Hiryankeshi and Bellary Nala. At Khanapur, cloudburst devastated families as they lost their homes and valuables. The first phase of the relief action of BDSSS, that is, immediate relief, reached out to 8500 families in 61 villages of 3 districts of the Diocese of Belgaum. 1700 volunteers worked tenaciously for a month to amass, stack, pack and deliver relief materials in the districts of Belgaum, Bagalkot and Dharwad.

The second phase was to restore shelters and livelihoods of select beneficiaries. An appeal was forwarded to the esteemed Archdiocese of Bangalore for support. His Grace, the Archbishop of Bangalore, Most Rev. Dr. Peter Machado and the donors from the Archdiocese were cordial in supporting the construction of 9 houses at Rs.4 Lakh each. A total grant of Rs.36 Lakh was conferred to BDSSS through Caritas India, following which BDSSS began the refurbishment in Khanapur and Ankali. 4 houses were constructed in Khanapur, whereas 5 in Ankali.

The Inauguration in Khanapur – 8th October 2020

After slogging hard for months, the BDSSS team in co-ordination with the Archdiocese and Caritas India, inaugurated 4 houses on 8th October 2020 in Khanapur. Blessing the occasion was His Grace, the Archbishop of Bangalore, Most Rev. Dr. Peter Machado, Most Rev. Dr. Derek Fernandes, Bishop of the Diocese of Belgaum and President of BDSSS, Msgr. Philipkutty Joseph, Vicar General, Rev. Fr. Naveen Kumar, Director, Bangalore Multipurpose Social Service Society (BMSSS) and the representatives of donors from the Archdiocese of Bangalore, i.e. St. Anne's Convent, Bangalore, St. Mary's Basilica Shrine,

Joining also were the other dignitaries and the well-wishers from the Diocese of Belgaum, Fr Clement, Fr Kustas Lima, Fr Albert D'Souza, Fr Felix Monteiro, Fr Mariadas, Fr Colman D'Souza, Fr Mathew Bardeskar and the Sisters of Kripa Niwas Convent. The keys of the houses were presented to the beneficiaries at a programme held at St. Milagris Church Hall. Speaking from the podium, His Grace, the Archbishop, Dr. Peter Machado was all praises for the efforts of BDSSS and Caritas India team in constructing the houses within the allotted budget and within the timeframe. He cited the scriptures and encouraged everyone with his words of harmony, peace and prosperity. The BDSSS President, Bishop Derek Fernandes thanked the Archdiocese for granting the project and congratulated BDSSS team for its defined field implementation.

Speaking on behalf of the beneficiaries, Miss Alpha Fernandes, recalled the appalling experience and the ache of losing her shelter. She thanked the teams of Archdiocese of Bangalore, Caritas India and BDSSS for extending a helping hand when she needed the most. The Governing Body member of BDSSS, Mrs. Clara Fernandes, conveyed the vote of thanks. The dignitaries were felicitated with flowers and shawls as a token of BDSSS' love and appreciation. The Inaugurations in Ankali – 9th October 2020

The following day, i.e., 9th October 2020, the teams visited Ankali village of Chikodi taluka to inaugurate the 5 houses. Ankali is on the banks of Krishna River and is a flood-prone region. The villagers organized a traditional welcome ceremony, a stage programme with felicitations for the guests followed by house visits for blessing. The Archbishop introduced the donors to the villagers and called for unity in diversity. He also addressed the media alongside the BDSSS President Bishop Derek Fernandes, updating the media about the works undertaken by the BMSSS of the Archdiocese and BDSSS of the Diocese of Belgaum in co-ordination with Caritas India.

Bishop Derek Fernandes called for the children of the village to study well and bridge the gap of aspirations and aptitude. "Everyone must dream of becoming topnotch officials one day and not just limit to menial chores" said Bishop Derek. The villagers reciprocated with thunderous applause. He also requested the Archbishop to carry the people's gratitude to every donor who supported the cause.

Mrs. Rajeshwari Metre, one of the beneficiaries and BDSSS SHG woman spoke her heart out thanking BDSSS for giving her a voice. She thanked BDSSS for helping them regain their lost paradise, their house and their home. She also admired and appreciated the efforts of Sr Arogyamary and her team for the regular visits and supervision in order to complete their dwelling. Similarly, other beneficiaries too expressed their gratitude. Rev Fr Peter Ashirwad, Asst Director BDSSS coordinated the programme.
